MEETING TOPIC: *Quality Review*

The Quality Review is a process that looks at how well schools are organized to support student learning and teacher practice. The New York City Department of Education (NYCDOE) developed the Quality Review to help schools in raising student achievement.

Members reviewed the Quality Review categories: school culture, instructional core and systems of improvement.

Mr. Henry noted that it appears as though the categories/ indicators may be changing. But the current document is helpful to understand the process and what is expected from schools.

Members focused on the items under a “Well-Developed” school. A discussion began about what is a “Culturally Responsive” school. Mr. Henry asked what would an evaluator have to see in our practice to identify us as a “Culturally Responsive” school?

Ms. Clara said that Teachers would be teaching students about other cultures.

Members went on to say that Teachers would truly need to know their students not just a name but who, where and how a student culturally identifies and frames the content with the students’ cultures in mind.

Mr. Henry questioned if this was practical –with so many students from different countries—how many cultural perspectives would a Teacher need to address or teach?

Ms. Hughes explained the importance of teaching about and from a student’s cultural perspective. She said that students need to learn how to get along with others of different races and cultures.
